

POSITION TITLE: **Dentist Part Time**

REPORTS TO: Dental Director

LOCATION: Brigham City

POSITION SUMMARY:

Performs professional dental care in the diagnosis and treatment of patients and assists the director in developing and implementing the dental program. Supervises dental residents and assists in their training.

SPECIFIC DUTIES:

The following information is intended to be representative of the essential functions performed by incumbents in this position and is not all-inclusive. The omission of a specific task or function will not preclude it from the position if the work is similar, related or a logical extension of position responsibilities.

1. Provides care in the following aspects of a general dental practice: such as, diagnosis, preventive dentistry, operative dentistry, pedodontics, periodontics, removable and fixed prosthodontics, endodontics and oral surgery.
2. Supervises dental residents and participates in their training.
3. Directs supervisory role over support staff.
4. Takes an active role, in collaboration with the Dental Director/Dentist, in ensuring the efficient and cost-effective operation of the dental clinic.
5. Participates in community outreach efforts.
6. Participates in the emergency call system.
7. Performs other duties as assigned in consultation with the Dental Director/Dentist.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Working knowledge of the diagnosis and treatment of dental diseases. Working knowledge of the principles, standard practices, methods and techniques of dentistry. Working knowledge of preventive dentistry and educational methodologies utilized in prevention. Skill in oral operative techniques and ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with patients and staff.

EDUCATION:

Graduation from an accredited school of dentistry. Completion of a GPR or AEGD very desirable.

EXPERIENCE:

Previous dental experience very desirable but not required. Desire to work with diverse populations required. Fluent Spanish/English language skills are preferred.

NECESSARY SPECIAL REQUIREMENT:

Possession of a license to practice dentistry in the State of Utah, or under Federal authority.
